

COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

In the Matter of Village Greens (1) at the junction of Mill Hill Road with Lutterworth Road, (2) at the junction of Brook Lane with Lutterworth Road, (3) east of St Peter's Road by the Baptist Church, (4) south of the Bank at its junction with Mill Hill Road, (5) at the junction of Mill Hill Road, Church Lane and Factory Lane and (6) east of St Peter's Road at its junction with Factory Lane, all in Arnesby, Harborough District, Leicestershire

## DECISION

These references relate to the ownership of lands being Village Greens (1) at the junction of Mill Hill Road with Lutterworth Road, (2) at the junction of Brook Lane with Lutterworth Road, (3) east of St Peter's Road by the Baptist Church, (4) south of the Bank at its junction with Mill Hill Road, (5) at the junction of Mill Hill Road, Church Lane and Factory Lane, and (6) east of the St Peter's Road at its junction with Factory Lane, all in Arnesby, Harborough District being the lands comprised in the Land Section of Register Unit Nos (1) VG. 20, (2) VG. 19, (3) VG. 18, (4) VG. 17, (5) VG. 16 and (6) VG. 15 respectively in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the Leicestershire County Council of which no person is registered under section 4 of the Commons Registration Act 1965 as the owner.

Following upon the public notice of these references no persons claimed to ' be the freehold owner of the lands in question and no other person claimed to have information as to their ownership.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the question of the ownership of the lands at Leicester on 22 July 1976. There was no appearance at the hearing.

In the absence of any evidence I am not satisfied that any person is the owner of the lands, and I shall accordingly direct the Leicestershire County Council, as registration authority, to register Arnesby Parish Council as the owner of the lands under section 8(3) of the Act of 1965.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
