DECISION

These disputes relate to the registration at Entry No.1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No.C.L.13 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Lincoln (Parts of Lindsey) County Council and are respectively occasioned by the conflicting registration at Entry No.1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No.V.G.30 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the Council and by Objection No. OB/5 made by Mrs. D.J.H.H.Meynell, Mr. N.E.H. Meynell, Mr. J.K. Winter and Mr. S.A. Spofforth and noted in the Register on 13th February 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the disputes at Lincoln on 12th March 1974. The hearing was attended by Mr. G.W. Livingston, solicitor, on behalf of the Blyton Parish Council, Mr. D.W. Ashton, solicitor, on behalf of the Registration Authority, and Mr. C. Fairman, solicitor, on behalf of Mr. D.W. Houlston, the present owner of land formerly owned by the Objectors.

Mr. Livingston stated that he did not wish to support the registration the subject of this dispute, but would call evidence in support of the conflicting registration.

I therefore refuse to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
