

In the Matter of Parish Land, Wood Enderby,  
Lincolnshire

## DECISION

This reference relates to the question of the ownership of land known as Parish Land, Wood Enderby, being the land comprised in the Land Section of Register Unit No. VG 25 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the Lincolnshire County Council of which no person is registered under section 4 of the Commons Registration Act 1965 as the owner.

Following upon the public notice of this reference no person claimed to be the freehold owner of the land in question and no one claimed to have information as to its ownership.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the question of the ownership of the land at Lincoln on 9 November 1981.

At the hearing the Wood Enderby Parish Meeting was represented by Mr M Clapham, its Clerk.

Mr Clapham informed me that the land in question was derelict in 1978, when it was let in two allotments, the rents of which have been paid to the East Lindsey District Council.

On this evidence I am not satisfied that any person is the owner of the land, and I shall accordingly direct the Lincolnshire County Council, as registration authority, to register the East Lindsey District Council as the owner of the land under section 8(3) of the Act of 1965.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.


