



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference Nos.22/D/64-66

In the Matter of Shoulder of Mutton Drove,
Crowland, Lincolnshire (No.2)

DECISION

These disputes relate to the registration at Entry No.1 in the Ownership Section of Register Unit No.C.L.59 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the former Holland County Council and are respectively occasioned by Objection No.158 made by Mr. E.W. Smith and noted in the Register on 22nd January 1971, Objection No.175 made by Mr. W. Clough and noted in the Register on 5th April 1971, and Objection No.306 made by the Trustees of the Will of the 5th Earl of Normanton and noted in the Register on 1st August 1972.

All the persons entitled to be heard at the hearing of these disputes have agreed upon the terms of the decision to be given by me and have sent to the Clerk of the Commons Commissioners particulars of such terms signed by or on behalf of all such persons.

I am satisfied that there is no person who, if a hearing were held, would be entitled to be heard upon giving his name and address to me and satisfying me that he had succeeded to the interest, or part of the interest of any other person.

I am willing to give a decision in accordance with the proposed terms and I accordingly refuse to confirm the registration.
