



In the Matter of Brumstead Common,  
Brumstead, Norfolk (No 1)

DECISION

---

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No 1 in the Rights section of Register Unit No CL 383 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Norfolk County Council and is occasioned by Objection No 363B made by Mr J E Ames, the Chairman of the Brumstead Parish Council and noted in the Register on 20th January 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Norwich on 14 March 1978. The hearing was attended by Mr A D K Wood, solicitor, on behalf of the Brumstead Parish Council. There was no appearance by or on behalf of Mr R N Beck, the applicant for the registration, but before the hearing his solicitors informed the Clerk of the Commons Commissioners by letter that Mr Beck had decided to "withdraw" his claim.

In these circumstances I refuse to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
