



In the Matter of Choseley Road Chalk Pit,  
Thornham, Norfolk (No. 1)

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Rights section of Register Unit No. CL 121 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the former Norfolk County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 371B made by W/Cdr C Dunkerley and noted in the Register on 23 March 1972.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at King's Lynn on 30 June 1977. The hearing was attended by W/Cdr Dunkerley. There was no appearance by or on behalf of Mr H B J Bett, the applicant for the registration, but in a letter to the Clerk of the Commons Commissioners dated 16 June 1977 Messrs Walters Vandercom & Hart, his solicitors, requested me to "cancel" his claim to common rights over this land.

In these circumstances I refuse to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
