



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

In the Matter of Church Plantation,  
Wood Dalling, Broadland D

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No CL. 207 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Norfolk County Council and is occasioned by Objection No 382B made by Sir John Woolmer White and noted in the Register on 15 August 1972.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Norwich on 13 January 1977. The hearing was attended by Mr D C O'Neill of Messrs Hood, Vores & Allwood who appeared for Sir John Woolmer White and there was no appearance on behalf of the Wood Dalling Parish Council which registered the land as common land.

Mr O'Neill produced a vesting assent dated 20 October 1976 whereby the land in question, identified on a plan annexed thereto, was vested in Sir John Woolmer White. In the absence of any Entries in the Rights Section and any evidence that the land is waste of a manor I must sustain Sir John Woolmer White's objection and refuse to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
