

COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No 225/U/172

In the Matter of Elm Farm Green, Horsham St Faith, Norfolk

DECISION

This reference relates to the question of the ownership of land known as Elm Farm Green, Horsham St Faith, being the land comprised in the Land Section of Register Unit No VG 115 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the Norfolk County Council of which no person is registered under section 4 of the Commons Registration Act 1965 as the owner.

Following upon the public notice of this reference no person claimed to be the freehold owner of the land in question and no one claimed to have information as to its ownership.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the question of the ownership of the land at Norwich on 23 May 1978.

There was no appearance at the hearing.

In the absence of any evidence I am not satisfied that any person is the owner of the land, and I shall accordingly direct the Norfolk County Council, as registration authority, to register the Horsham St Faith and Newton St Faith Parish Council as the owner of the land under section S(3) of the Lot of 1965.

I am required by regulation 50(1) of the Commons Commissioners is elections 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erronsous in point of law may, within 5 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to swate a case for the decision of the High Court.
