## In the Matter of Hales Green, Hales,

Norfolk(No. 2)

## DECISION

This dispute relates to the registrations at Entry Nos. 1,3 and 4 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No. CL.39 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the former Norfolk County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 220B made by Mrs. B.A. Crisp and noted in the Register on 18th November 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Norwich on 23rd April 1975. The hearing was attended by Hr. B.E. Partridge, solicitor, on behalf of the South Norfolk District Council and by Hr. T.C. Bastin, solicitor, on behalf of the Objector.

The Objection relates only to a small part of the land comprised in the Register Unit. For the reasons given in my decision—In the Matter of Hales Green Hales (No. 1) (1975), Ref. No. 25/D/178 I have confirmed the registration in the Land Section of the Register Unit with the exclusion of the land the subject of the Objection, and it therefore only remains for me to confirm these registrations.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to emplain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erronecus in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
