



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No.25/D/7

In the Matter of Ling Common,  
Thornham, Norfolk (No.2)

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No.1 in the Ownership section of Register Unit No.C.L.55 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Norfolk County Council and is occasioned by Objection No.175B made by Henry Bourdillon Imlach Bett and noted in the Register on 15th October 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Norwich on 21st June 1972. The hearing was attended by Wing-Commader C. Dunkerley, the Chairman of the Thornham Parish Council, and by Mr. Matthew Horton, Counsel for the Objector.

At the same time I heard a dispute (25/D/6) relating to the registration in the Land section of the same Register Unit. Having refused to confirm the latter registration, I am now unable to confirm this registration and I accordingly refuse to do so.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
