



In the Matter of Massingham Green, Great Massingham,
Norfolk

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land section of Register Unit No. CL 385 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the former Norfolk County Council and is occasioned by the conflicting registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land section of Register Unit No. VG 172 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the Council.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at King's Lynn on 28 June 1977. The hearing was attended by Mrs S. Wright, a member of the Great Massingham Parish Council, the applicant for the conflicting registration. There was no appearance on behalf of the Norfolk Association of Amenity Societies, the applicant for the registration.

In the absence of any evidence to support the registration I refuse to confirm it.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
