In the Matter of New Road Chalk Pit, Thornham, Norfolk (No. 2)

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 on the Ownership section of Register Unit No. CL 198 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the former Norfolk County Council and is occasioned by the conflicting registration at Entry No. 2 in the same section of the Register Unit.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at King's Lynn on 30 June 1977. The hearing was not attended by any person entitled to be heard, but in letters to the Clerk of the Commons Commissioners, and the Clerk of the Thornham Parish Council before the hearing, Messrs Walters Vandercom & Hart, solicitors for Mr H B J Bett, the applicant for the conflicting registration, stated that he no longer wished to pursue his claim to ownership.

In these circumstances I confirm the registration made on the application of the Thornham Parish Council.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous <u>in point of law</u> may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
