



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference Nos. 225/D/28 & 29

In the Matter of Piece of land at Hill Common
adjoining the Broad Hickling, N. Norfolk D

DECISION

These disputes relate to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land Section and the Entry No. 1 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No. CL.315 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Norfolk County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 284B made by Major J M Mills and noted in the Register on 24th February 1971.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Norwich on 11th January 1977. The hearing was attended by Mr S S F Horner of Messrs. Francis Horner and Son on behalf of Major Mills. Messrs. Capron & Helliwell by letters dated 10 December 1976 and 5 January 1977 withdrew the registration in the land section on behalf of Hickling Parish Council and the Entry in the Rights Section on behalf of Mr Belson the applicant for rights. In these circumstances I have no alternative but to refuse to confirm both registrations as I was requested to do by Mr Horner.

I am required by regulation 30 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
