



In the Matter of Roydon Common,
Roydon, Norfolk (No 2)

DECISION

These disputes relate to the registrations at Entry Nos 1, 3 and 4 in the Rights section of Register Unit No CL 77 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the former Norfolk County Council and is occasioned by Objection Nos 203B and 288B, both made by the Norfolk Naturalists Trust, and Objection No 240B made by Major W P Riley. and all noted in the Register on 24 November 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at King's Lynn on 13 January 1978. The hearing was attended by Mr P W E Britton, solicitor, on behalf of Mr R A Croot, the applicant for the registration at Entry No 1, Mrs V E Patrick and Mrs E Rasberry, the executors of Ms M Panks, the applicant for the registration at Entry No 3, and Mr F J E Rose, the applicant for the registration at Entry No 4, and by Mr E H Dodds, solicitor, on behalf of Messrs J & P Bennett and Mr J B Backes, the successors in title of Major Riley. Major Riley's Objection related only to the western part of the land comprised in the Register Unit.

I was informed that the parties had agreed that the exercise of the rights should not extend to an area somewhat less than the area the subject of Major Riley's Objection, which was indicated on an agreed plan.

In these circumstances I confirm the registrations with the modifications necessary to give effect to the agreement between the parties.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
