

COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No. 25/U/39

In the Matter of The Green, Tittleshall Breckland D.,

DECISION

This reference relates to the question of the cwnership of land known as The Green Tittleshall, Breckland District being the land comprised in the Land Section of Register Unit No. VG.64 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the Norfolk County Council of which no person is registered under section 4 of the Commons Registration Act 1965 as the owner.

Following upon the public notice of this reference no person claimed to be the freehold owner of the land in question and no one claimed to have information as to its ownership.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the question of the ownership of the and at Norwich on 14 January 1975.

In the absence of any evidence, I am not satisfied that any person is the owner of the and, and I shall accordingly direct the Mcrfolk County Council, as registration authority, to register Tittleshall Parish Council as the owner of the land under section (3) of the Act of 1965.
