



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

In the Matter of The Skirts,
Cley, N Norfolk D

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No CL. 285 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Norfolk County Council and is occasioned by Objection No 97B made by Norfolk Naturalist Trust and noted in the Register on 10 August 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Norwich on 11 January 1977. The hearing was attended by Mr J H Howard of Messrs Cozens-Hardy & Jewson on behalf of Norfolk Naturalists Trusts and by Mr Stargroom and Mrs Savory the chairman and vice chairman of the Cley Parish Council.

Mr Howard satisfied Mr Stargroom and Mrs Savory that the Trust was the owner of the land in question, they had no evidence that the land was waste of a manor and there are no Entries in the Rights Section. In these circumstances Mr Stargroom and Mrs Savory accepted that the Entry in the Land Section made on the application of the Parish Council should not be confirmed.

For this reason I refuse to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
