ollowing upon the public notice of this reference Breckland District Council claimed be the freehold owner of the land in question and no other person claimed to have information as to its ownership.

n the absence of any evidence I am not satisfied that any person is the owner of the and, and it will therefore remain subject to protection under section 9 of the Act f 1965.
