



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No.25/D/163

In the Matter of Three Pieces of Land in
the Village of North Runcton, Norfolk.

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No.1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No.CL 434 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the former Norfolk County Council and is occasioned by Objection No.224B made by Mr C.E.Fuller and noted in the Register on 24th March 1971.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Norwich on 26th June 1974. The hearing was not attended by any person entitled to be heard, and in a decision dated 15th July 1974 I refused to confirm the registration.

I subsequently received an application on behalf of Mr R.J.H.Holmes, the applicant for the registration, to reopen the hearing and set aside my decision under Regulation 21 of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971. I granted this application. Since I granted the application all the persons entitled to be heard at the hearing of this dispute have agreed upon the terms of the decision to be given by me and have sent to the Clerk of the Commons Commissioners particulars of such terms signed by or on behalf of all such persons.

I am willing to give a decision in accordance with the proposed terms and I accordingly confirm the registration with the following modifications:- namely, the exclusion of the southernmost of the three pieces of land comprised in the Register Unit.
