

In the Matter of Various Pieces of Common Land,
Denver, Norfolk (No. 1)

DECISION

These disputes relate to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land section of Register Unit No. CL 244 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the former Norfolk County Council and are occasioned by Objection No. 383 B made by the Central Electricity Generating Board and noted in the Register on 11 May 1972 and the conflicting registrations at Entry No. 1 in the Land section of Register Unit No. VG 92 and Entry No. 1 in the Land section of Register Unit No. VG 93.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at King's Lynn on 30 June 1977. The hearing was attended by Mr J C Sharpe, the Chairman of the Denver Parish Council, who informed me that the Court Leet of Common Right Owners, the applicant for the conflicting registrations, did not wish to pursue those registrations, and that it had been agreed between the parties concerned that this registration should be confirmed with certain modifications.

In these circumstances I confirm the registration with the following agreed modifications:- namely, the exclusion of

- (1) The land the subject of Objection No. 383 B;
- (2) The land comprised in the Register Unit to the west of Denver station; and
- (3) The splayed entrance to the disused drive adjoining the A10 road to the north of the Golf Club House.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
