In the Matter of Village Green, East Rudham West Norfolk District, Norfolk

## DECISION

This reference relates to the question of the ownership of land known as Village Green, East Rudham, West Norfolk District being the land comprised in the Land Jection of Register Unit No. VG.30 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the Morfolk County Council of which no person is registered under section 4 of the Commons Registration Act 1965 as the owner.

Following upon the public notice of this reference no person claimed to be the freehold owner of the land in question and no person claimed to have information as to its ownership.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the question of the ownership of the land at Hings Lynn on 27 Hovember 1975. At the hearing East Budhum Parish Council were represented by Mr 7 8 Potter their chairman.

In Potter said that the Parish Touncil could affer no evidence of awnership. In the absence of any evidence, I am not satisfied that any person is the  $\sqrt{\phantom{a}}$  owner of the land under section S(3) of the Lot of 1965.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Moumons Journissioners Regulations 1971 to emplain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 5 weeks from the late on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
