



## COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No.225/U/142

In the Matter of Weasenham Lyngs, Weasenham  
All Saints Breckland D.

DECISION

This reference relates to the question of the ownership of land known as Weasenham Lyngs Weasenham All Saints Breckland D being the land comprised in the Land Section of Register Unit No.CL.392 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Norfolk County Council of which no person is registered under section 4 of the Commons Registration Act 1965 as the owner.

Following upon the public notice of this reference the Trustees of the Charity known as the Fuel Allotments Weasenham All Saints and Weasenham St.Peter claimed to be the freehold owner of the land in question and no other person claimed to have information as to its ownership.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the question of the ownership of the land at Kings Lynn on 26 October 1977.

Mr R P W Chapman chairman of the Trustees of the above mentioned Charity appeared and there was also available to me at the hearing an affidavit supplied by the Charity Commission sworn by P G J Mackey on the 18th October 1977 and the Exhibits thereto which established that the land in question was vested in the Trustees of the said Charity.

On this evidence I am satisfied that the Trustees of the Charity known as the Fuel Allotment Weasenham All Saints and Weasenham St. Peter are the owners of the land, and I shall accordingly direct the Norfolk County Council, as registration authority, to register the Trustees of the Charity known as the Fuel Allotment Weasenham All Saints and Weasenham St. Peter as the owners of the land under section 8(2) of the Act of 1965.

I am required by regulation 30 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
