



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No. 268/D/318-319

In the Matter of Blubberhouses Moor in
the Parishes of Blubberhouses, Timble Great
Harrogate B

DECISION

These disputes relate to the registrations at Entry No. 1 and Entry No. 2 in the Ownership Section of Register Unit No. CL 481 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the North Yorkshire County Council and are occasioned by the conflict between the two registrations.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the disputes at Harrogate on 11 March 1981. The hearing was attended by Mr N F Davenport, Solicitor, appearing on behalf of the applicants for registration at Entry No. 1, and by Mr C R Harrop, Solicitor, of the Yorkshire Water Authority, the successors to the applicants for registration at Entry No. 2.

A written Agreement dated 11 March 1981 between the parties was produced, the effect of which is that the land comprised in Entry No. 2 is to consist of two areas respectively hatched green and blue on the plans attached to the Agreement, the remainder of the land being the subject of Entry No. 1. I shall give effect to the Agreement by confirming the registration at Entry No. 1 modified by the exclusion in column 4 of these two areas: and by confirming the registration at Entry No. 2 modified by substituting the two areas for the existing Particulars in column 4.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
