

COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

In the Matter of Calton Moor, Craven D

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 2 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No. CL 409 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the North Yorkshire County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 178 made by W J Henderson and noted in the Register on 15 March 1971.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Skipton on 19 October 1982. At the hearing Mr W Foster, Solicitor, appeared on behalf of the applicants for registration, and Mr D V Evans, Solicitor, on behalf of the Objector. Ms Claire Brooks, Solicitor, appeared on behalf of the executors of James Thomson, who are not however parties to the dispute.

Entry No. 2 includes a right of shooting and sporting of all manner of game and rabbits, which is the same as the right considered in my Decision on Sawbanks, Calton (Ref. 268/D/411). The parties and the circumstances are the same in both cases, which were heard together at the hearing, and for the reasons given in that Decision, which are of equal application to this case, I confirm the registration modified by deleting the right of shooting and sporting.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
