DECISION

This dispute relates to the registrations at Entry Nos 1 and 2 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No.CL.43 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the North Yorkshire County Council and is occasioned by Objections Nos. 34 and 35 made by the former Yorkshire River Authority and noted in the Register on 25 August 1972.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Selby on 10 December 1981. The hearing was attended by Mr S R Harrop, Solicitor, on behalf of the Yorkshire Water Authority, the statutory successor of the Objector. There was no appearance by or on behalf of any of the other persons entitled to be heard, but Mr Harrop informed me that he was instructed not to pursue the Objections.

In these circumstances I confirm the registrations.

I am required by regulation 30 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
