



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No.268/D/13

In the Matter of Flaxton Village Green
and Common Land, Flaxton, North Yorkshire
(No.2).

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registrations at Entry Nos.1 to 19 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No.CL 54 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the former North Riding County Council and is occasioned by Objection No.0202 made by Bass Ltd and noted in the Register on 23rd September 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Malton on 11th February 1975. The hearing was attended by Mr A.R.Turnah, the Clerk of the Flaxton Parish Council, on behalf of the applicants for the registrations, and by Mr L. Lennox, solicitor, on behalf of the Objectors.

The facts relating to this dispute are recited in my decision in In the Matter of Flaxton Village Green and Common Land (No.1), Ref.No.268/D/12. Having come to the conclusion that the applicants' rights of grazing extend to the whole of the land comprised in the Register Unit, it follows that I must confirm the registrations.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
