



In the Matter of Freeholders Wood and other Land,  
Carperby, North Yorkshire (No. 2)

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land section of Register Unit No. CL 138 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the former North Riding of Yorkshire County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 0219 made by Mr J U Machell and Sir Henry Lawson-Tancred and noted in the Register on 25 September 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Richmond on 20 July 1977. The hearing was attended by Mr E R D Johnson, solicitor, on behalf of Mr E H Williams, in consequence of whose application for a registration in the Rights section of the Register Unit this registration was made, and by Mr J H N Towers, solicitor, on behalf of the Objectors.

Having decided to confirm applications for registrations in the Rights section of the Register Unit with certain modifications set out in my decision in In the Matter of Freeholders Wood and other Land, Carperby (No. 1), (1977) Ref. No. 268/D/95, it follows that, for the reasons there given, I confirm this registration with the following modification: namely the exclusion of the River Ure to the east of Harpers Wath Bridge.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
