DECISION

These disputes are occasioned by (1) the conflicting registrations at Entry No. 3 in the Land section of Register Unit No.VG. 124 in the Register of Town or Village greens maintained by the North Yorkshire County Council and in the Land section of Register Unit No.CL.382 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Council (2) Objection No. 2070 made by Yorkshire River Authority and noted in the Register of CL.382 on 24 August 1972.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the disputes at Selby on 9 July 1985. At the hearing Cawood Parish Council was represented by its Clerk, Mrs J Sykes, and Mr R Simpson, Solicitor, appeared on behalf of the Water Authority.

Mr Simpson told me that the Authority's Objection was now withdrawn. The registrations of Gill Green both as a village green and as common land were made on applications by Cawood Parish Council and Mrs Sykes told me that the Parish Council wished it to remain a village green. There are no rights registered in the register of CL. 382, and in the circumstances I shall confirm the registration as village green, and refuse to confirm the registration in the Land Section of CL.382.

I am required by regulation 30 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
