



In the Matter of Great Ayton Moor and Little Ayton Moor,  
Great Ayton and Little Ayton, North Yorkshire.

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 2 in the Rights section of Register Unit No. CL 192 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the former North Riding of Yorkshire County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 0466 made by the Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries, and Food and noted in the Register on 2 August 1972.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Northallerton on 8 March 1977. The hearing was attended by Mr F Mallovs, of counsel, on behalf of the Minister. There was no appearance by or on behalf of Mr D C Petch, the applicant for the registration.

The Objection relates only to part of the land comprised in the Register Unit. Since there is no evidence to support the application in so far as it relates to that part of the land,

I confirm the registration with the following modification, namely, the addition to the particulars in column 4 of the words "other than the area shown verged red on the plan marked A attached to Objection No. 0466".

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
