



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No.268/D/132

In the Matter of Greer Lane and Cauldron Mill Lane,
Padmoor and Skiplan, North Yorkshire.

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No.1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No.CL 186 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the former North Riding County Council and is occasioned by Objection No.0289 made by Mr M.Bulmer and noted in the Register on 8th October 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Malton on 13th February 1975. The hearing was attended by Mr J.N.L.Burn, solicitor, on behalf of Mr Bulmer. Mr J.P.Sunley, Mr S.H.Wass and Mr R.Frank, the applicants for the registration, did not appear and were not represented, but in a letter from their solicitors to the Clerk of the Commons Commissioners, dated 3rd February 1974, it was stated that they were "withdrawing" their claim, having satisfied themselves that such claim was ill-founded.

In these circumstances I refuse to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
