



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference Nos.268/D/202-3

In the Matter of Hawsker Lane,  
Hawsker-cum-Stainsacre, North Yorkshire.

DECISION

These disputes relate to the registration at Entry No.1 in the Land section of Register Unit No.CL 316 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the former North Riding of Yorkshire County Council and are occasioned by Objection No.0472 made by the County Surveyor and noted in the Register on 3rd August 1972 and Objection No.0521 also made by the County Surveyor and noted in the Register on 22nd August 1972.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Whitby on 4th June 1975. The hearing was attended by Mr P.M.White, solicitor, on behalf of M/s M.L.A.Strickland, the applicant for the registration, and by Mr M.H.Lightfoot, solicitor, on behalf of the Objector.

The land comprised in the Register Unit consists of two long strips on either side of Hawsker Lane.

Mr White and Mr Lightfoot informed me that they had agreed upon the form which my decision should take. I accordingly confirm the registration with the following modification:- namely the exclusion of all the land on the east side of Hawsker Lane within 15 feet of the centre of the carriageway.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
