



In the Matter of Lawkland Fell, Craven D

---

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 7 in the Rights section of Register Unit No. CL 104 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the North Yorkshire County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 64 made by Thomas N Airey and noted in the Register on 6 August 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Skipton on 8 October 1980. The hearing was attended by Mr R Bowker, Solicitor, appearing on behalf of Mr Airey. Entry No. 7 is of a grazing right and was registered on the application of Mr H Nowell. The objection was that the right does not exist. Mr Nowell did not appear and a message had been received that he now withdrew his application. In the circumstances, I refuse to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
