



In the Matter of Little Fell at or
near Deepdale, Buckden

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 2 in the Rights section of Register Unit No. CL.245 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the North Yorkshire County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 220 made by Messrs. W A G and D M Watson and noted in the Register on 23 December 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Skipton on 2 July 1985. The hearing was not attended by any person entitled to be heard. There is, however, on the file a letter dated 7 May 1985 from Walker Charlesworth and Foster of Skipton solicitors for the objectors withdrawing the objection. There being nothing on the face of the registration which appears to be questionable I confirm it.

I am required by regulation 30 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
