

COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No. 268/D/310

In the Matter of Little Moor Head, Stainforth

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 2 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No. CL 458 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the North Yorkshire County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 453 made by Mr T Metcalfe and noted in the Register on 21 April 1971.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Skipton on 9 October 1980. The hearing was attended by Mr R Bowker, Solicitor, appearing on behalf of Mr R H Preston, the applicant for registration of the Entry. The Entry is of a grazing right: the Objection had been withdrawn and accordingly I confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
