



In the Matter of Littleaside, Carlton Town, North Yorkshire.

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No 1 in the Land section of Register Unit No VG 200 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the former North Riding of Yorkshire County Council and is occasioned by the conflicting registration at Entry No 1 in the Land section of Register Unit No CL 173 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Council.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Richmond on 10 May 1978. The hearing was attended by Mr J C Scott, solicitor, on behalf of the Carlton Town Parish Council, the applicant for both registrations.

Mr Scott informed me that the Parish Council wished to have the registration the subject of this reference confirmed and the conflicting registration modified by the exclusion of the land comprised in this Register Unit.

In these circumstances I confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
