

COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference Nos 260/D/130 and 131

In the Matter of Moor End, Sutton on the Forest, Hambleton D

DECISION

These disputes relate to the registration at Entry No 1 in the Ownership Section of Register Unit No CL. 184 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the former North Riding County Council and are occasioned by the conflicting registration at Entry No 2 in the said Ownership Section.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the disputesat York on 1 July 1976. The hearing was attended by Mr Peel chairman of the Sutton on the Forest Parish Council. Capt Wombwell who under Entry No 2 claimed to be the owner of the land in question withdrew his claim.

For this reason I refuse to confirm the registration at Entry No 2 and I confirm the Entry No 1.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
