



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No. 44/D/39

In the Matter of Outgang Lane,
Osbaldwick, Yorkshire (North Riding).

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No.C.L.94 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the North Riding of Yorkshire County Council and is occasioned by Objection No.0101 made by the Town Clerk of York and noted in the Register on 10th July 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Malton on 11th April 1973. The hearing was attended by Mr.H.H. Milner, the Clerk of the Osbaldwick Parish Council, which applied for the registration. Mr. Milner informed me that the Parish Council did not any longer contend that the land in question is common land and that he would therefore not be calling any evidence in support of the registration.

In the absence of evidence I refuse to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
