



In the Matter of Part of the River Swale and  
Land adjacent thereto, Brompton on Swale,  
North Yorkshire (No 2)

DECISION

---

These disputes relate to the registration at Entry No 1 in the Rights section of Register Unit No CL 195 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the former North Riding of Yorkshire County Council and are occasioned by Objection No 067 made by Tilling Construction Ltd and noted in the Register on 13 July 1972 and Objection No 0437 made by the former Yorkshire River Authority and noted in the Register on 26 July 1972.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Richmond on 10 May 1978. The hearing was attended by Mr R H Kellet, solicitor, who appeared on behalf of Tilling Construction Ltd.

In a letter dated 13 April 1978 addressed to the Clerk of the Commons Commissioners the solicitors for Mr and Mrs R B Hindmarsh, the applicants for the registration, stated that their clients did not wish to proceed with their application.

In these circumstances I refuse to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
