



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

In the Matter of Part of Windross Square
& The Market Place, Easingwold, Hambleton D

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registrations at Entry Nos 1, 2, 3 and 4 in the Ownership Section of Register Unit No CL. 120 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the former North Riding of Yorkshire County Council and are occasioned by the conflicting registration at Entry No 5 in the Ownership Section of the said Register.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at York on 29 June 1976. The hearing was not attended by any person entitled to be heard. Capt Wombwell who claimed ownership of the whole of the land in question by a letter dated 30 May 1975 written on his behalf by his solicitors Messrs Walters Vandercom & Hart withdrew his said claim to ownership.

For this reason I refuse to confirm the registration at Entry No 5 and confirm the Entries at Nos 1, 2, 3 and 4.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
