



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No.268/D/231

In the Matter of Pieces of Land at Fearby
Cross, Fearby, Healey and District,
North Yorkshire (No.1).

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No.1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No.VG 213 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the former North Riding of Yorkshire County Council and is occasioned by the conflicting registration at Entry No.1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No.CL 389 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Council.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Harrogate on 7th May 1975. The hearing was attended by Mr A. Nunn, the Clerk of the Fearby, Healey and District Parish Council.

Both this registration and the conflicting registration were made by the Registration Authority without application. Mr Nunn informed me that the Parish Council wished to support this registration.

There being no evidence in support of the conflicting registration, I shall regard this registration as being unopposed, and I therefore confirm this registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
