



In the Matter of Quarry Hills, Harmby,
North Yorkshire (No 3)

DECISION

These disputes relate to the registration at Entry No 1 in the Rights section of Register Unit No CL 263 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the former North Riding of Yorkshire County Council and are occasioned by Objection No 0109 made by Mr E Auton and noted in the Register on 5 August 1970 and Objection No 0406 made by Mrs G E Watson and noted in the Register on 22 June 1972.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Richmond on 11 May 1978. The hearing was attended by Mrs Watson in person. There was no appearance by or on behalf of either Mr Auton or Mr R C Mason, the applicant for the Registration.

In the absence of any evidence in support of the registration, I refuse to confirm it.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
