



In the Matter of Scruton Village Green,
Scruton, North Yorkshire (No. 3)

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 2 in the Ownership section of Register Unit No. VG 2 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the former North Riding of Yorkshire County Council and is occasioned by the conflicting registration at Entry No. 1 in the same section of the Register Unit.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Northallerton on 9 March 1977. The hearing was attended by Mr Christopher Proctor, solicitor, on behalf of the Scruton Parish Council, the applicant for the registration at Entry No. 1² and by Miss Z L Chilton, the applicant for the registration at Entry No. 2, who spoke through her brother, Mr J G H Chilton.

For the reasons given in my decision in In the Matter of Scruton Village Green, Scruton (No. 2), (1977) Ref. No. 268/D/236 I have come to the conclusion that the Parish Council has acquired a possessory title to the land, and I therefore confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
