



In the Matter of Ten End Peat Moor,  
Wether Fell and Waste Land, Hawes,  
North Yorkshire (No. 2)

DECISION

These disputes relate to the registrations at Entry Nos 1 - 41 in the Rights section of Register Unit No CL 145 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the former North Riding of Yorkshire County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 013 made by Mr A J Rowntree and noted in the Register on 8 May 1969 and by Objection No. 0447 made by the Lord's Trustees of the Manor of Bainbridge and noted in the Register on 28 July 1972.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Richmond on 21 July 1977. The hearing was attended by Mr E R D Johnson, solicitor, on behalf of the Lord's Trustees of the Manor of Bainbridge and by Mr J S Huntington, solicitor, on behalf of Mr Rowntree's executors.

Objection No. 013 related to part only of the land comprised in the Register Unit, and Mr Johnson informed me that his clients were content that the land the subject of the Objection should be excluded from the Register Unit.

Objection 0447 related only to the registration at Entry No. 38. This registration is of a right to graze sheep to a limit of 17 gaits, one gait giving the right to graze 5 sheep. By a letter dated 18 July 1977 addressed to the Clerk of the Commons Commissioners Mr M T Metcalfe, the successor in title of Ms F. E. A. Parker, the applicant for this registration, stated that he agreed to the modification of the registration by the reduction of 5 sheep to one.

There being no objection to the other registrations, I confirm the registrations with the following modification:- namely, the substitution in Entry No. 38 of the figure "1" for the figure "5".

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
