



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No. 268/D/73

In the Matter of The Green, Little Barugh,  
Barugh (Great and Little), North Yorkshire (No.4)

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registrations at Entry Nos.1 to 6 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No.VG 194 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the former North Riding County Council and is occasioned by the conflicting registration at Entry No.1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No.CL 28 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Council.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Malton on 12th February 1975. The hearing was attended by Mr W.L.Edgar, the Clerk of the Barugh (Great and Little) Parish Meeting, and by Mr B.Robinson, surveyor, on behalf of Miss E. Bowes and Mrs A.Metcalf, Objectors to Entry No.6 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No.VG 194.

For the reasons given in my decision in In the Matter of The Green, Little Barugh, Barugh (Great and Little) (No.1), Ref.No.268/D/69 I have refused to confirm the registration of the land in question in the Land Section of Register Unit No.VG 194. It therefore follows that I must also refuse to confirm the registrations the subject of this dispute.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
