DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No. CL.380 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the North Yorkshire County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 1156 made by Mr E Elcock and Objection No. 2068 made by Yorkshire River Authority, noted in the Register respectively on 7 June 1971 and 24 August 1972.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Selby on 9 July 1985. At the hearing Mr C F Eyre, Solicitor, appeared on behalf of Mr D A Riley, successor in title to Mr Elcock: Mr R Simpson, Solicitor, appeared on behalf of Yorkshire Water Authority: and Cawood Parish Council was represented by its Clerk, Mrs J Sykes.

The Parish Council was the applicant for registration and had since notified its decision to withdraw the registration: this was confirmed by Mrs Sykes.

In these circumstances I refuse to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law, may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
