



In the Matter of the Village Green,
Cray Buckden

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the land section of Register Unit No.VG.151 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the North Yorkshire County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 218 made by W.A.C. Watson and D.M. Watson and noted in the Register on 29 March 1971.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Skipton on 2 July 1985. The hearing was attended by Mr D. Hird who wished to support the registration the original applicant, Major Horner being dead.

It appeared, however, that the green had been wrongly described in the notice of hearing. I accordingly adjourned the case until 21 May 1986 when Mr Hird again attended. No one else wished to be heard.

Objection 218, which was the only objection, was withdrawn by letter on 7 May 1985. There being no reason to doubt the validity of the registration I confirm it.

I am required by regulation 30 (1) of the commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
