



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference Nos 268/D/133 and 134

In the Matter of The Village Green,  
Crayke, Hambleton D

DECISION

These disputes relate to the registration at Entry No 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No VG. 195 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the former North Riding of Yorkshire County Council and are occasioned by the conflicting registration at Entry No 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No CL. 188 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Council.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at York on 30 June 1976. The hearing was attended by Mr G W Robertson chairman of the Crayke Parish Council which had registered the land in question as both Common Land and a Village Green.

Mr Robertson invited me to confirm the Entry in Unit VG. 195 and to refuse to confirm the Entry in Unit 188 and I accede to his invitation.

For these reasons I refuse to confirm the registration in the Land Section of Unit CL. 188 and I confirm the Entry in the Land Section of Unit VG. 195.

+ as required by regulation 50(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
