



In the Matter of The Village Green, Old Byland,
North Yorkshire (No. 3)

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registrations at Entry Nos 1 and 2 in the Rights section of Register Unit No. VG 103 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the former North Riding County Council and are occasioned by Objection No. 0335 made by Mr D Swift and noted in the Register on 23 October 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Malton on 11 October 1977. The hearing was attended by Mr Swift and by Mr J E Mainwaring-Taylor, solicitor, on behalf of Mr E L Bentley, the applicant for the registration at Entry No. 1. There was no appearance by or on behalf of Ms M J Colley, the applicant for the registration at Entry No. 2. However, Mr Swift stated that he was no longer objecting to either registration.

In these circumstances I confirm both registrations.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
