DECISION

These disputes relate to Entries Nos. 3, 4 and 5 of the Rights Section of Register Unit No. CL 100 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the former West Riding of Yorkshire County Council and are occasioned by objection Nos. 809, 310 and 311 all made by Leonard Bradley entered in the Register on 19th May 1971, 4th December 1970 and 4th December 1970 respectively, objections Nos. 841, 365 and 420 all made by A.L. Dean and entered in the Register on 19th May 1971, 15th December 1970 and 23rd December 1970 respectively and objections Nos. 804, 328 and 329 all made by Fenwick & Co and entered in the Register on 19th May 1971 9th December 1970 and 9th December 1970 respectively.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring / ^{into} these disputes at Skipton on 22nd July 1975.

The hearing was attended by Mr. Williams Foster of Messrs. Walker Foster and Charlesworth solicitors for all three objectors, Mr. Wilson and Mrs. Harrison on behalf of Threshfield Parish Council and Mr. T. Denvir.

The land in question is a small part of Threshfield Moor which was omitted from Register Unit No CL 30 and I was told that it is unfenced and indistinguishable from Unit No CL 30 both as regards the land itself and the rights claimed over it. In these circumstances I heard the disputes relating to CL 30 first; References Nos 45/D/49 to 57, and it was accepted by all concerned that the evidence given at that hearing and my decision as to Unit CL 30 would be applicable to Unit No CL 100.

For these reasons and the reasons given in my decision on Unit No CL 30 of even date I refuse to confirm the Entries at Nos 3, 4 and 5 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No. CL.100

I am required by regulation 30 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
