

COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registrations at Entry No. 1 in the Land Section and at all the Entries in the Rights Section of Register Unit No. CL 35 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the North Yorkshire County Council and is occasioned by Objections No. 496 and 184 made by Mr H Plews and noted in the Register.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Skipton on 17 October 1984. The hearing was attended by Mr R M N Gillibrand of Oglethorpe, Sturton and Gillibrand, Solicitors of Lancaster who appeared for all parties and informed me that it had been agreed that none of the registrations should be confirmed.

For this reason, I refuse to confirm any of the registrations.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
