



In the Matter of Ugthorpe Moor, Ugthorpe,
North Yorkshire (No. 2)

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registrations at Entry Nos 1 to 26 in the Rights section of Register Unit No. CL 137 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the former North Riding of Yorkshire County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 045 made by Mr J J Readman and noted in the Register on 10 February 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Whitby on 3 June 1975. The hearing was attended by Mr A B Foundling, the applicant for the registration at Entry No. 5, Mr D Marshall, the successor in title of Mr G Wilson, the applicant for the registration at Entry No. 11, Mr T M Hill, the applicant for the registration at Entry No. 14, and Mr K Bagshawe, solicitor, on behalf of the Objector.

The Objection was to the inclusion in the Land section of part of the land comprised in the Register Unit. For the reasons given in my decision in In the Matter of Ugthorpe Moor, Ugthorpe (1975), Ref. No. 268/D/88 I confirmed the registration in the Land section with the exclusion of the land the subject of the Objection. This leaves the registrations in the Rights Section without any standing objection.

For these reasons I confirm the registrations.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
